JOINT COMMITMENT OF MAYORS

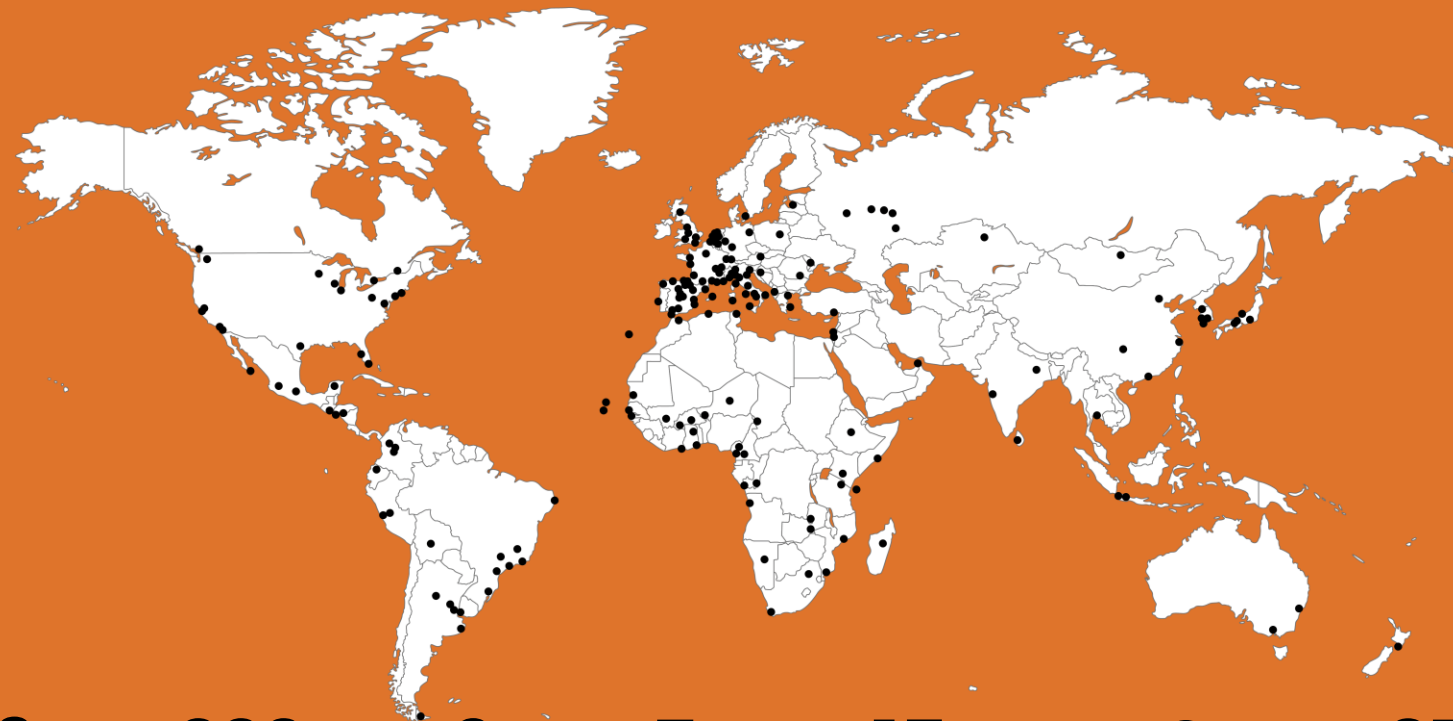
Launched by the **Mayor of Milan** as legacy of **Expo Milan 2015 "Feeding the Planet"**, it is a global joint cities declaration to promote Urban Food Policy.

Milan Pact defines **sustainable food systems** as inclusive, resilient, safe, diverse and healthy and promote a set of **37 recommended actions** to define food policies clustered in 6 categories:

- 1. GOVERNANCE**
- 2. SUSTAINABLE DIETS AND NUTRITION**
- 3. SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC EQUITY**
- 4. FOOD PRODUCTION**
- 5. FOOD SUPPLY AND DISTRIBUTION**
- 6. FOOD WASTE**

FOOD WASTE REDUCTION



The City of Milan developed in 2015 the Milan Food Policy that acts on the **urban food system** with a multidimensional approach around 5 key priorities, 16 guidelines, 18 actions:

food losses and waste reduction being one of the most important, engaging several local actors such as **research centers, food businesses, food banks, non profit organizations, foundations.**

MUFPP Recommended Actions

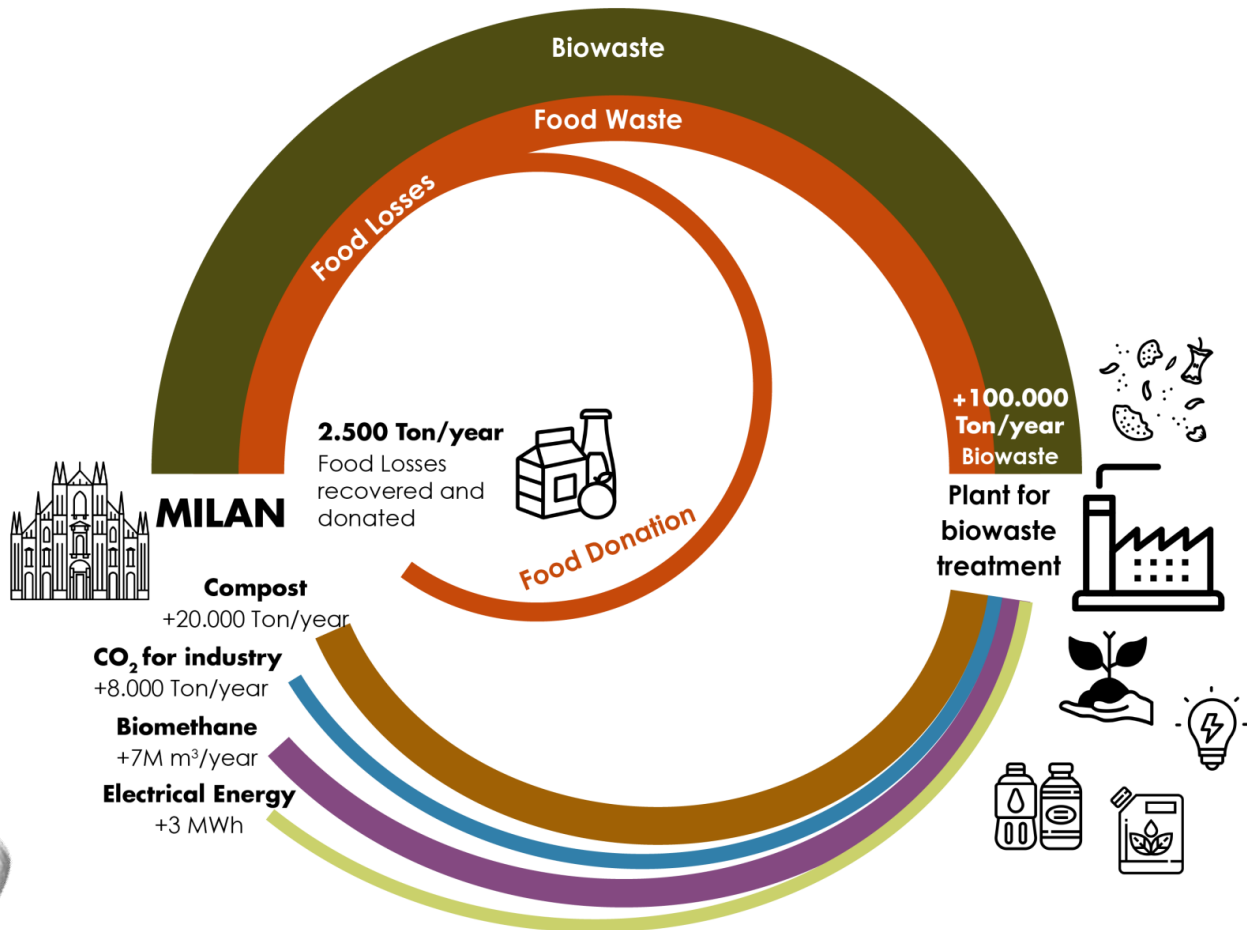
- #34. **Convene food system actors to assess** and monitor food loss and waste reduction at all stages
- #35. **Raise awareness of food loss and waste** through targeted events and campaigns.
- #36. **Collaborate with the private sector** along with research, educational and community-based organizations to develop and review, as appropriate, municipal policies and regulations.
- #37. Save food by facilitating **recovery and redistribution for human consumption** of safe and nutritious foods

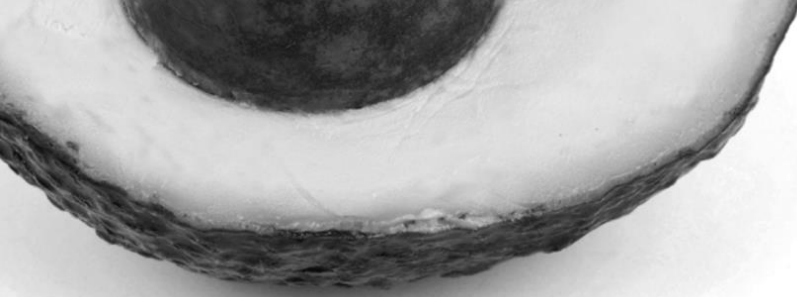

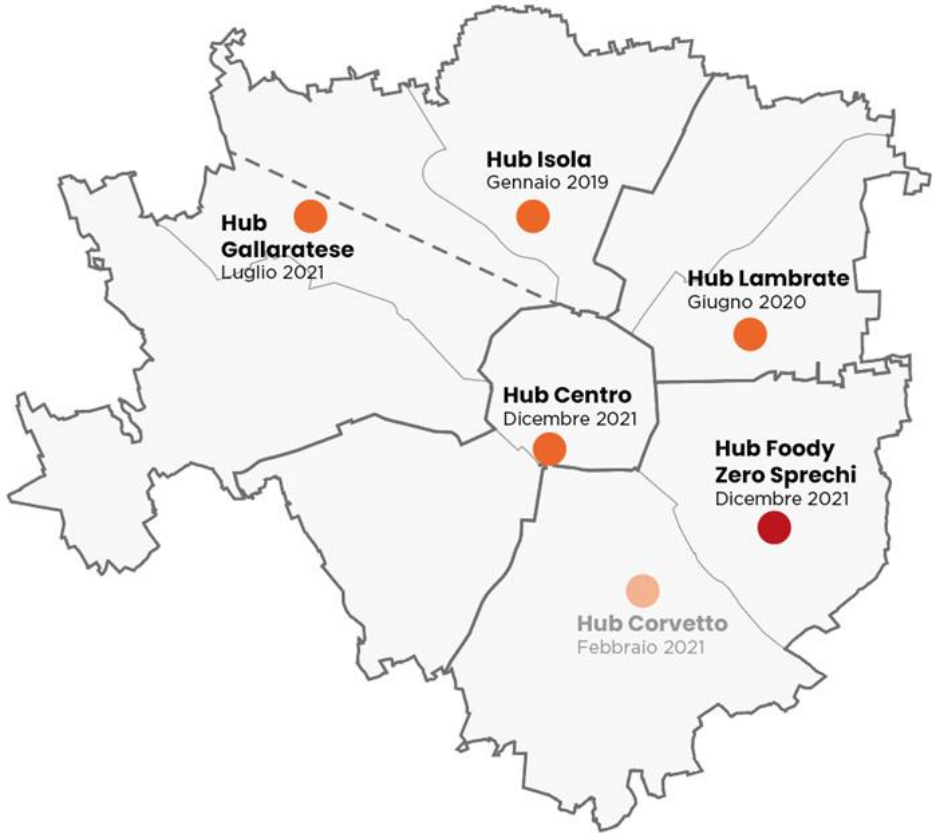
